

Macon Mayhem Education Day Game - Things to Know & FAQs
Thursday, March 20, 2025 at 10:30AM

What time should I arrive?

The actual hockey game will begin at 10:30AM, so we will open the doors to the facility starting at 9:00AM. We do anticipate heavy traffic and some potential delays getting into the venue, so we recommend trying to arrive as early as possible.

Where is the event located?

The event will be held at the Macon Coliseum found at the following address:

Where do we park upon arrival?

Please look in your welcome packet for some additional information regarding your school's designated parking lot, along with driving directions for your arrival in your area. Your designated color zone is listed on your welcome cover page and is also provided inside your welcome packet (based on your school's seat location). Please ONLY park and enter the building in your designated color zone. Please also make sure your bus is displaying your provided parking pass (in your welcome packet).

** There will be no specific dismissal order following the event, please have your group exit the facility through the same entry point back to your bus parking.

Where will my school be seated?

Each school will be given a block of tickets based on the final numbers provided to the Mayhem. Please refer to your welcome packet to see your listed section, rows, and seats. Because this event is expected to **SELL OUT**, it is imperative that each student, teacher, and chaperone sit in the seat **printed on their ticket**.

Section numbers are displayed around the arena, and you'll also find a seating map provided in your welcome packet. Once you arrive to the arena, ushers, security members, and Mayhem Staff will be easy to locate for further assistance.

How does the game work and how long with the game last?

Hockey is made up of three (3) 20-minute timed periods and two (2) intermissions taking place after the 1st and 2nd periods are played. Each intermission is roughly 20 minutes each. The average game in total will last around two hours and 20 minutes – we anticipate the game ending around 1:00PM.

What else is there to do around the arena?

We encourage all schools to stay in your seats while the game is in play. Throughout the hockey game, you will be able to enjoy many different educational components, videos and dance parties. Around the arena, there will be various exhibits, displays, games, prizes, etc.

for your groups to observe and interact with. Additionally, all arena concessions will also be available. Feel free to take members of your group around the arena as you see fit.

What about lunch? When should we eat?

Lunch will NOT be included with this field trip, but the Macon Coliseum will have concessions available for purchases. It is recommended that each school works directly with their cafeteria to request bagged lunches for the event. Students are also permitted to bring their own lunch from home into the venue. When bringing lunch to the venue, we ask that you please bring it in either a brown paper bag or a clear disposable/grocery bag (teachers will be allowed to bring in coolers to store student's lunches).

Feel free to distribute lunch to your students whenever you would like throughout the game. Students and chaperones can eat directly in their seats.

Are bags allowed?

Students are **NOT** allowed to bring bags, backpacks, etc. into the Macon Coliseum (please leave them on the bus). Teacher and chaperones **WILL** be permitted to bring bags with medical equipment and other necessary items for their school. Please be advised that all bags will be checked at the doors and **ALL** patrons will have to go through metal detection upon entering the facility.

Should students bring anything with them? Will they need money?

If your school wants to bring your worksheets with you, students can bring a book and something to write with. Additionally, there will be a few things that students/chaperones are able to purchase during the game if they wish:

- Concessions (\$5.00 - \$15.00)
 - Full concessions will be available around the Coliseum. They offer the following – hot dogs, chicken tenders, hamburgers, cheeseburgers, fries, chips, ice cream, cotton candy, soft drinks, and more! Concession stands will be opened until the end of the 2nd intermission.
- Mayhem Merchandise (\$2.00++)
 - Visit the Mac Shack in the Macon Coliseum lobby to get your favorite mayhem swag!
- Chuck-A-Puck Game (\$5.00)
 - Visit the Chuck-A-Puck table behind Section 116 to purchase. Students can purchase foam pucks to throw onto the ice during the 2nd intermission's game to win great prizes! Pucks are 5 for \$5.
